## Job Purpose:

To be responsible for supporting, maintaining and enhancing the quality of the catechetical work in the parish.

## Principal duties and responsibilities of Catechetical Co-ordinator

- To coordinate and promote catechetical programmes in the parish, including the following: First Holy Communion, Confirmation, baptismal preparation, Children's liturgy, to organise and prepare material for classes and liturgies and to oversee the parish RE classes.
- 2. To identify, empower and co-ordinate the recruitment and ongoing training and personal formation of all the volunteer catechists in the parish programmes
- 3. Offering advice and encouragement to catechists and having knowledge of new resources available.
- 4. Organisation of classes and co-ordination of curriculum
- 5. Regular meeting with catechists to review, prepare and develop programmes to be followed.
- 6. General involvement in parish pastoral matters as required.

7. To support and promote initiatives for the development of youth ministry in the parish.
