# **Principal duties and responsibilities**

1. To facilitate, coordinate and support Westminster Youth Ministry outreach to youth and young adults.

- 2. To establish and develop links of Westminster Youth Ministry with Catholic schools and parish youth groups.
- 3. To contribute and support retreat related activities at SPEC Retreat Centre.
- 4. To develop and set up volunteering scheme for young people wanting to be involved in supporting retreats at SPEC while at school. Develop formation and support framework for the scheme.
- 5. To develop and deliver training programmes for volunteers, paid youth ministers and young leaders. Evaluate training programmes used in parish based youth ministry.
- 6. To assist in delivery of Diocesan Youth Events.
- 7. To contribute to the strategy for parish based ministry.
- 8. To work collaboratively with other diocesan departments; to collaborate with diocesan and national youth ministry networks when necessary.
