### Job Purpose:

To maintain a clean, safe, and welcoming environment in the parish buildings in support of the parish mission

# Principal duties and responsibilities:

- 1. To undertake general cleaning duties within the Presbytery. This includes:
- To hoover all presbytery rooms.
- To clean all communal areas such as the stairs, sitting room, and dining room
- To clean and mop the surfaces of all bathrooms and toilets
- To clean and polish all floors and surfaces
- To clean doors and interior windows as required
- To dust walls and curtains as required
- 2. To undertake laundry duties as required (wash, dry and iron bed linens and towels from Presbytery)
- 3. To undertake other ad hoc cleaning duties as required in the Presbytery.

Note: These responsibilities are carried out weekly to ensure all general presbytery laundry is washed, dried, and ironed using parish equipment (washing machine, dryer, etc) as required.

The Housekeeper/Cleaner is expected to monitor the stock of cleaning materials and request additional supplies on time.
